Hong Kong, XX Aug 2018 – Hong Kong Adventist Hospital (HKAH) and Hong Kong Adventist Hospital Foundation (HKAHF) are delighted to announce a press conference for a fundraising event titled "Adventist's Got Talent". The press conference will be held on September 6, 2018 at Hong Kong Adventist Hospital Stubbs Road campus.

With the success of the Women of Hope (WOH) annual luncheon earlier in May, which raised over HK\$5.3 million, we are hopeful that "Adventist's Got Talent", to be held on December 2, 2018 at Hong Kong Adventist Hospital (Tsuen Wan), will have similar success.

"Adventist's Got Talent" aims to raise much-needed donations for the Medical Fund (Tsuen Wan) in order to support patients who lack access to financial means and medical care. All proceeds from this event will be directed to both medical cases such as Cardiac, Oncology, and Orthopedics, and charity programs. The charity programs, including the Diagnostic Imaging Charity Program, are for beneficiaries who are plagued by chronic illness, suffering, and uncertainty, and are designed to restore hope, joy, and quality of life to them. One of HKAHF's beneficiaries, Ms. Huang Yi Yan, a Stage 4 Lung Cancer patient whose targeted Therapy treatment is being supported by the HKAHF, will be in attendance at the press conference on September 6.

During the "Adventist's Got Talent" on December 2, a special hair shaving ceremony will be conducted along with voluntary performances to raise awareness for these cancer patients. To shed some light on the reasoning for hosting the hair shaving ceremony, such an act is arranged as a visible and tangible show of solidarity with cancer patients. Held by one of the main advocates of HKAHF, Mr. Kim Robinson, this ceremony also has deeply personal connotations for the prestigious hair maestro as his mother passed away due to cancer. Next, with regards to the voluntary performances, interested participants are welcome to join the Talent show individually or in teams to perform acts such as singing etc.
